Structure of the SGVCOG Water Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) 6.

Recommended Action: Discuss and provide direction to staff.

The TAC discussed compiling a list of topics to provide technical assistance to the Water Policy Committee. For example, new permit, implementation of Measure W. The TAC could provide assistance to the various Measure W committees (particularly the scoring Committee) as a means to provide oversight of Measure W implementation. Other topics

the TAC could provide input:

- Water use efficiency
- Recent legislation that impacts water districts
- Rollup reporting, retail/wholesale, importance of coordination.
- Updates to Urban water management plans
- Water conservation, and how to collaborate among different agencies

A potential future presentation for the TAC is the Upper District 2-year legislative plan. It was recommended that EWMP updates be a more robust component of the Water Committee agenda. These EWMP updates would discuss overall technical reports and other requirements/activities as many are overlapping, this is in contrast to the EWMP updates being watershed specific currently. The TAC agreed that the separate TAC meeting should begin at 9:30 AM.
