- 5. <u>Chairman's Remarks</u> Chair Muela reported that she and Paul Hubler met with California Transportation Secretary David Kim on July 19. The meeting was organized by Mobility 21 and Secretary Kim outlined his priorities. Paul Hubler serves on the Advisory Committee of Mobility 21.
- 6. <u>Member Comments</u> Member Lyons reminded the Committee to attend the special meeting of the Governing Board to discuss allocation of \$126 million in Measure M Subregional Equity Program funds to the God Line Foothill Extension project.
- 7. Chief Engineer's Monthly Report Mr. Christoffels indicated the community meeting held to discuss the Turnbull Canyon Road project was very well attended. He reported that staff submitted an application for the fiscal year '19 Build Program. The application sought \$20 million for the Montebello project and awards will be announced in November. Lastly, Mr. Christoffels reminded the Committee that during procurements members should refrain from communications with firms intending to or who have proposed. He asked that all questions regarding procurements be referred to SGVCOG Contract Manager.
- 8. **Project Progress Reports** Phil Balmeo, Senior Project Manager reviewed project photos for the Durfee Avenue grade separation projects that showed cable relocations, excavation for storm system and pump system. He indicated Preshoofly construction work was also underway.
- 9. <u>Presentation on Public Outreach efforts</u> Paul Hubler, Director of Government and Community relations reviewed comprehensive elements of the current community and business outreach program. He indicated various forms of communication were used including mailers, 24-hour hotline, email, web posting, hand delivery of information and twitter.

Mr. Hubler reminded the committee of the business outreach efforts that included additional signage to show "businesses open during construction", advertisements in local papers and mailers as well as participation in coupon programs.

Chair Muela reminded the Committee to re-tweet agency tweets.
